Disaster Legal Services (DLS)

is provided for survivors of presidentially declared major disasters through a Memorandum of Agreement between FEMA and the Young Lawyer's Division of the American Bar Association. DLS cases that are received by FEMA are referred to private attorneys through a lawyer referral service.

- ▶ Proof of ownership
- Assistance with insurance claims for doctor and hospital bills, property loss, loss of life, etc.
- ► Counseling and advice about landlord/tenant issues
- Drafting powers of attorney
- ► Home repair contracts and contractor disputes
- Consumer protection matters
- Estate administration, including guardianships
- Advocacy for disaster assistance grants from FEMA and other federal agencies
